

WRCS Guidelines for Car Line

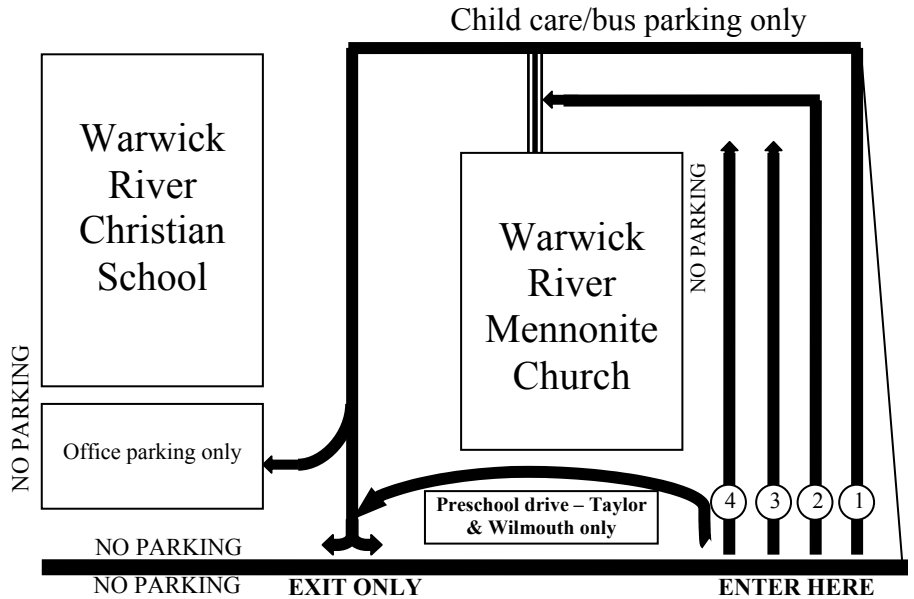
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These guidelines apply to everyone transporting students or conducting business with the Warwick River Christian School. Thank you for helping to keep our students safe!

1- Follow directions from the car line officials, obey signs that say “do not enter,” and park in spaces designated for disabled drivers/passengers only if the driver has a physical disability and is coming to the office OR if the vehicle is transporting a physically disabled student to or from the school.

2- The loop around the church is one-way only during car line (8:00-9:00, 11:15-11:45, and 2:30-3:30). No parking in the last 5 spaces on the far side of the church (near the buses).

3- **There are 4 main car lines**, counting from the right side of the entry drive. 1 goes all the way around to the school, and 2 can pull up to the Child Care crosswalk. 3 and 4 need to stop at the speed bump. Line 1 should be against the grass. Close the space between cars (front/back and side/side), merge only as directed, and keep the active line moving. You will be directed to pull up to the school in groups of 7 vehicles to unload



or load students. When all students from the group of cars have been safely unloaded or loaded, the whole group may proceed out of the drive in an orderly fashion. No passing is permitted at this time.

4- The traffic circle in front of the church is **only** for the pre-school students of Mrs. Taylor and Mrs. Wilmouth. Mrs. Watrous' 4K students are to be dropped off at the back of the church.

5- Parking on or across Lucas Creek Road and walking your student to school is **dangerous and not permitted for any reason.**

6- **On those rare occasions when you need to pick up a student for an appointment between 2:45 and 3:15, please check with the car line coordinator at the car line entrance on how to proceed.**

7- By the time a student enters 5 year Kindergarten, he/she should be able to go to class unaccompanied. We ask that you encourage this developmentally important independence, and let him/her walk to class by him/herself. School staff/assistants are available to guide them as needed.

8- If you have business in the school office, go through car line to drop off or pick up your student(s) then pull into the lot in front of the school. This lot is not to be used to deliver students unless you are late to school and they need to sign in at the front office.

9- Students not picked up by the end of car line (3:25 or so) will be taken to the Child Care Center, where hourly fees apply.

10- Be courteous. Wait your turn in line, use turn signals, and be a team player. Our goal is to operate the car line in the safest, most efficient manner possible.
